#### **English**

In English, we have been learning about different techniques to use in our writing. The children have been looking at writing noun phrases, subordinating and coordinating conjunctions and learning to write speech using correct punctuation. We have just started to explore our new text "The Pirates of Scurvy Sands". The children are very excited to see what happens to the characters.

# **Mathematics**

The children have been focusing on different types of measurements. They have used a range of equipment to represent their measuring, both standard and non-standard units. They have so far explored weight, mass, volume and capacity. The children enjoyed using a range or equipment to aid their learning.

They have been continuing to learn and develop their rainbow recall fluency skills and earning their certificates and badges.

# <u>Science</u>
