English

<u>Science</u>

Our topic this half term is 'Materials' where we have started off by looking at different materials. The children have been learning the different properties and identifying them. They have looked at how different items can be recycled and created posters explaining how to reduce, reuse and recycle materials more.

<u>Topic</u>

The children have begun learning about the seaside with brilliant enthusiasm. Already this term, they have learnt to identify differences between seasides of the past and of current day. The children have started their Design Technology project for this term where they have designed a fully functioning Ferris wheel. So far, the children have been able to design, measure, strengthen, adapt and assess the functionality of their creations.
