English

In English, we have been enjoying our new class text 'Tom's Sausage Lion' by Michael Morpurgo. So far, the children have used imaginative description to write a poem about a lion. As well as creating a story map to retell the story, the children loved roleplaying to act out scenes from the story. Later, Year 3 used the power of persuasion to write a letter to convince people that the lion is real.

Mathematics

Year 3 have recently finished their maths unit of time. The children learned how to tell the time to the minute. As well as learning to tell the time, the children enjoyed learning the days in the month song. We have recently started our new topic on measuring mass and capacity. The children are able to read scales in grams and kilograms as well as litres and millilitres.

Science

In Science, the children are learning all about plants. The children enjoyed carrying out an investigation to find out what plants need to grow healthy. We learned that plants that have sunlight, warmth and water grow well compared to plants that do not have all three. Year 3 are looking forward to dissecting a plant to find and name the different parts of a flower.

Topic

This half term, the children are continuing to enjoy their topic of the Seaside. Year 3 are excited about our craft-based Art topic. The children have thoroughly enjoyed making their tie-dye t-shirts where they decided which folding method to use for their design, before selecting their colour choice based of their mood boards.
