## Important Covid-19 Information Update

14th December 2020

Dear Parent/Carer,

You may have seen in the media recently the Department for Educations (DfE) announcement that schools are permitted to make Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December a 'non-teaching' day. I am writing to reassure you that we will <u>not</u> be amending our term dates or our scheduled INSET days at any point during this academic year as we recognise the significant knock on effect this will have on families. This means our last day of term for pupils will remain, Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December.

We will still ensure that we are contactable via email if there is a positive case over the weekend leading up to Christmas. The Government's published guidance is a little unclear as to how educational settings will fulfil this requirement, and therefore I will try to clarify how we will as a school manage this commitment between the end of term and Christmas Eve. Below is an extract from the DfE guidance and a summary table the school has devised as to how this specifically relates to our school:

- Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should not be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.
- For the first 6 days after teaching ends, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.
- School staff are not asked to remain on-call or conduct any contact tracing more than 6 days after the final day of teaching. Where a schools last teaching day is on Thursday 17 December, there should be no pupil contact tracing asks beyond Wednesday 23 December.

- Parents to seek tests via testing centres rather than via postal tests as this can significantly delay confirmation of results. Results are normally forthcoming in 24 hours via test centres.
- Parents to notify school if children have symptoms after schools close (as outlined above) even
  when waiting for a test result, families can be advised to take necessary steps whilst awaiting
  confirmation.
- So as to minimise the risk of infection within school (and the wider community) please ensure you continue to adhere to social distancing protocol.
