

Mathematical development

The children have been making different shapes with the play dough using the various tools and cutters. They have named and described them.

They have continued to count with rhymes, numicon and buttons. As well as exploring the concept of after and next.

Literacy development

They have also been finding letters in the water tray and learning their sounds.
