Mathematical development

The children have practising their counting by saying the number names in order '1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10' forwards and backwards '10 9 8 7 6 5 4 3 2 1'. They have been joining in with the rhyme 'Ten Bears in the Bed' and counting how many bears are left in the bed.

This week the children have been using cardboard boxes and the wooden blocks inside and outside to make models. They have been encouraged to talk about what they have made and about the shapes they have used.
