Mathematical development

The children have looked at pictures of tall and short building before having a go at building towers. They have been using the language of size to describe their towers including big, small, tall and short. Also they have been listening to the story of 'The Three Bears' and talking about big daddy bear, medium sized mummy bear and small baby bear.
