







### Year Four Curriculum Information-Summer Term 2014

Welcome back to Winhills. Below is an outline of what we will be covering in the curriculum over the summer term in year four.

<b>Literacy</b> 	Children will be studying a range of units this term including explanation texts and stories from other cultures. They will be learning all about South America both in the classroom and in the ICE Zone. We will be looking at a range of texts throughout our literacy units and working hard to meet reading and writing targets.
<b>Numeracy</b> 	The children are continuing to practise the four operations - adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing with an emphasis in problem solving. They are developing these skills by using larger numbers and decimal numbers. In the ICE Zone the children will focus on fractions and data handling.
<b>Science</b> 	Work will focus this term on all living things. The children will investigate how we move and grow and natural habitats. We will also be looking at electricity and how circuits and conductors work in the ICE Zone.
<b>ICT</b> 	This term the children will be using ICT across a range of lessons. We will be using a variety of maths websites which the children can also access from home. In the ICE Zone the children will be using ICT for research.
<b>P.E</b> 	This term the children will be developing their cricket skills. Year 4 will also be taking part in Zumba.
<b>Music</b> 	Music lessons will focus on singing in preparation for the summer performance. Year 4 are also continuing with Indian drumming this term.
