








Year Three Curriculum Information-Summer term 2014.

<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>This term is off to an exciting start in Year 3. We have been selected to participate in the storytelling festival during the second week of the term. We will be re-telling the story of The Gingerbread Man with storytelling actions. From this we will be re-writing the stories with our own twists. After the half term we will be embracing the end of year play by learning all about play-scripts.</p>
<p>Numeracy</p> 	<p>Numeracy lessons will typically be three times a week this term and will focus on our addition and subtraction and how to solve word problems. We will be advancing our written methods in all the four operations, too. In the ICE zone there is a focus on number bonds and fractions as well as the shape work in the blocks.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>Our unit for Science is helping plants grow well. A perfect time of the year to get out into the garden and research into plants and what they require to grow to their full potential. We will be learning about the insides of a plant and how all the parts of the plant work together.</p>
<p>ICT</p> 	<p>The children will be using ICT across a range of lessons and within the ICE zone using Starz to research and explore their questions. The children will also be using the bee bots to programme.</p>
<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>This term we are exploring the theme of Seaside. The 1,2,3 ICE zone looks fantastic with a rock pool, a fish and chip shop and a Punch and Judy show. The children will be exploring the history of seaside towns and how they developed our tourist industry.</p>
<p>P.E</p> 	<p>During this term the children will have a range of different PE lessons including Gymnastics on a Monday, Games with Mr Franco on a Tuesday, Dance on a Wednesday and Indian Drumming on a Thursday. Year 3 are also privileged to have a specialist PE coach to teach them Cricket on a Thursday afternoon. Year 3 have a 2 week timetable and the children will have all of the above sports at least once every two weeks.</p>
<p>Music</p> 	<p>Every Thursday morning the year three class will be attending Indian drumming. Indian drumming provides knowledge in rhythmic beat and pattern. Also, every Wednesday morning there will be a music class covering different areas for the children to practise and explore. We will also have the KS2 end of year play which we will be practising for.</p>
