## **Communication and Language**

This term we will be learning to share our ideas in sentences using the word 'and'; follow instructions with two parts and ask questions to find out more about something that interests us. We will learn new stories and rhymes and change them up to make them our own. We will learn how to use non-fiction books.

# Personal, Social and emotional development

This term we will be learning how to express our feelings clearly with our friends and respect their feelings too. We will learn how to manage our own feelings in the face of frustration. We will learn to manage our own personal hygiene and the importance of a balanced diet and lifestyle with plenty of Superveggies!

## **Physical Development**

This term we will learn how to move in different ways and develop our core strength and balance as we move along the obstacle courses that we build. We will develop our coordination through ball games and see if we can beat our personal best in Superhero boot camp. We will develop our pencil control to form the letters that we learn in phonics by using tweezers, paintbrushes, chalks and scissors.

#### **Understanding the world**

This term we will learn to talk about our families, people that help us and people that are important to us. We will use our senses to explore our local environment and describe what we see, hear and feel whilst on our super adventures. As the season changes from summer to autumn we will take walks to observe the changes.

### **Expressive arts and design**

This term we will learn to mix paint and use a variety of tools to make different marks for effect. We will explore different printing strategies including string, sponges, potatoes and we will learn a new song each week and explore putting our song to music. We will retell the stories we have shared with puppets and experiment by innovating them with our own ideas.

#### Literacy

This term we will share the stories of Supertato, Funny bones, Little Red Hen and Peace at Last. We will learn how to talk about books and share them with our friends. We will draw story maps to help us retell the stories and make up some of our own. We will learn individual sounds and learn to blend them to read words. We will begin to use those sounds to write lists, captions and phrases about the characters in the books that we have shared.

# Maths

This term we will learn to sort, group and compare objects thinking about 'more', 'less' and 'the same as'. We will learn how to accurately count objects, sounds and actions. We will explore repeating patterns and patterns that can be made with the same number of objects and match the numerals to those patterns. We will start to record our thinking in simple drawings. We will develop our understanding of size and shape as we explore different structures with the wooden blocks and construction materials.
