

Dear parents,

We are writing to let you know the details of returning to school on the 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021.

Firstly, I would like to thank you for all your support over the last half term with supporting your children's home learning. We are very excited to be welcoming them back to school and I am sure that they are also excited to be returning. We have set up class zooms so that class teachers can talk to your children about what to expect on their return. Please do phone in if you have any other concerns.

Below we will outline important information for you ready for your return.

-Parents will be required to wear a mask when on site. (if you are exempt, please let the school office know and ensure you wear appropriate identification)

-Whilst on the playground, we need to ensure that we are social distancing from other families. There are marks on playgrounds to indicate where to stand.

-The bike shed will continue to <u>not be open</u> so scooters and bikes will have to be taken home by parents.

## Year 6:

Start date: 8th March 2021

- **Drop off** for Year 6 is at 8:30am. (please note the continued earlier start.) Please ensure your child arrives on time to allow for hand washing, as the lessons will be starting earlier.
- Only one parent to drop off.
- Please come in via the gate by Year 3/4 (from the car park)
- Bring your child to the steps at the bottom of Year 6 and drop them off and exit at the bottom gate by the trim trail.
- **<u>Picking up</u>** for Year 6 is at 3.00pm.
- Please come in via the gate by Year 3/4 (from the car park) and join the queue following the social distancing markers
- Please be patient as we send the children to you.
- Exit back across the playground via the gate at the trim trail gate
- Year 6 children are still able to walk home as usual, however, we are stressing that they should not be congregating outside of school. If this happens, we will insist on collection.

The school office will no longer be functioning as usual:

- Only use the office if your issue cannot be solved through an email or phone call first
- You must queue outside the office following the social distancing markers
- If your child is going to be late because of an appointment or similar, you will need to ring the office to arrange where to drop your child off.

## There will be no bags brought into school. Your child will need to bring:

- · Clean school uniform
- · Named water bottle (no water fountains available)
- · Named sunhat
- · Packed lunch (if needed)
- · Sun cream applied before school

 $\cdot$  On your PE day, your child can come to school in their PE kit and remain in it all day. For Year 6 this will be every Wednesday.
