English:

In English the children have started a new topic this week. They are learning how to write a non-chronological report about the Great Fire of London. They will be using their ICE zone research to complete their reports. The children have already learnt about fiction and non-fiction texts this week and they will be learning about the key features of non-chronological reports.

In their Read, Write, Inc lessons the children have continued to apply their phonics to their reading and their writing. The children have been working hard to create their Big Write all about the 'History off the page day'.

Mathematics:

In Miss Larbey's Maths groups, the children are exploring place value. They have learnt about the 'greater than' and 'less than' signs and they have used them in number sentences. The children have also ordered numbers and have been practising writing numbers in words and numerically.

In Miss Brock's and Mrs Goodwin's Maths groups the children have been learning to make block graphs. The children have been interpreting and presenting data. They have also collected their own data by holding class votes about their different favourite items.
