English

In English the children are writing their own stories based on 'The snail and the whale'.

The children have changed the characters, changed the journey the characters go on and changed the ending. We have focused on using fantastic adjectives and noun phrases.

Mathematics

Year 1 the children have started learning about time. They have used clocks to tell the time to o'clock and half past.

The year 2 children have been preparing for Year 3 by learning the column method to add and next week they will learn how to subtract. They have also been learning the place value of hundreds.

Science

The children have planted their own beans. They have been looking after their plants and observing the changes when they occur. The children were very excited about this! We have set an experiment where we have put the beans in different conditions to see which is the best condition to grow a healthy plant.

We are also discovering and identifying different types of wild flowers and types of trees.
