Our progress this term

The children have learnt to read and write 27 sounds as a result they can now segment and blend to read cvc words. They understand that some words are trickier and need to be read on sight (he, she, me, we, be). They are writing their names and applying their skills to lists, notes, cards and letters.

The children are counting objects accurately and beginning to add single digit numbers. They are even answering questions such as '22 children are here today. There are 17 on the carpet. How many are we waiting for?'

They have drawn, painted and collaged some amazing pictures. They have built complicated and intricate constructions. The children have explored patterns through printing and rhythm and beat through the percussion instruments.

They have developed their coordination and balance through gymnastics, scooters, ball games and large building equipment.
