Literacy

This week the children have learnt the sounds 'ng' and 'nk'. They have been focusing on their blending skills to read new words.

The children have also been sharing different versions of the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. They have compared the alternate versions and thought of their own.

In modelled writing sessions the children have made their own posters to sell houses.

Maths

The children have been focusing on their counting and addition skills. They have used the vocabulary altogether, total, add, plus, and makes. The children have used counters, pennies, unifix cubes and other objects to support their thinking. They have started to record their work in number sentences.

They have begun to count forwards and backwards on a number line to answer questions such as 'what is 3 less than 20?'

Useful Information
