Mathematical development

The children have been ordering objects by weight and length. They have use the terms small, smaller, smallest and long, longer, longest to order 3 objects. They have applied their learning by building towers with the bricks.

The children have developed their knowledge of 2D shape. They have correctly identified circles, squares, triangle, hexagons, pentagons and semi circles. They have applied their learning by finding shapes in the environment and making pictures.
