<p>Children should be reading at least four evenings a week for 20 minutes or every day for at least 10 minutes.</p> <p>Please log reading in diaries, this can be either completed by the child or an adult.</p> <p>Children's reading will be monitored in school.</p> <p>Thank you for your support with your child's reading. Initialling their reading log really helps to monitor reading that takes place outside of school.</p>	<p>Children are expected to complete 30 minutes of Maths Whizz each week.</p> <p>This will be monitored weekly in school.</p> <p>If there is no internet access at home, children should complete in school (having an option of homework club).</p>	<p>Like last term, children are expected to spend some time at home revising for SATs.</p> <p>School will provide revision material for children to use at home and will then re-review during 'booster sessions' in school.</p> <p>Leading up to SATs, children will be provided with spelling lists that show the types of words that children in KS2 are expected to be able to spell. Post SATs, we will continue teaching spellings and homework tasks will be similar to previous terms.</p>	<p>PE is taught on a Wednesday afternoon (by Mr Franco).</p> <p>For ease, please ensure Wednesday PE kit is kept in school. We will send home for washing when needed.</p>	<p>Staff in Amber class: Mrs Burns Mrs Lee (shared with Quartz class)</p> <p>For additional lessons leading up to SATs, children may be led by any member of the Year 6 team.</p> <p>Please ensure that water bottles are brought into school every day.</p> <p>If your child brings a mobile phone into school, please ensure that it is handed in to the teacher each morning. A mobile phone agreement should also be filled in. If you have any questions, please speak to one of the staff.</p>
