<p>We ask that the children read at least 5 times a week. Please record every time that you read with your child in their reading diary.</p> <p>A book talk should also be completed at least once a week. This can include retelling the story or asking questions about the book. You can record this as BT in the comments section of their reading diary.</p>	<p>Spellings are given out on a Wednesday and need to be handed in the following Monday. The children are expected to use their spellings in sentences as well as practising them. There will be a spelling quiz on a Monday afternoon.</p>	<p>The children need to complete 45 minutes of Maths Whizz homework and 15 minutes of Times Table Rock Stars homework each week.</p> <p>The week will run from a Friday to a Thursday. We will be checking Maths Whizz and TT Rock Stars on a Thursday night to see if they have completed the correct number of minutes.</p>	<p>PE will be on a Friday morning. Please ensure that your child has an appropriate PE kit for the changing weather. This includes suitable footwear. Earrings must be removed and long hair must be completely tied up.</p> <p>Until May half term, the children will have Forest School on a Tuesday. Please ensure they come appropriately dressed with their uniform and a change of footwear in their bags.</p> <p>We will be doing more outdoor learning this term so please can they have wellies and a change of trousers/leggings in school every day.</p>	<p>Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the changing weather. This includes a suitable waterproof coat.</p> <p>Please make sure that all items of clothing are named.</p> <p>All children should bring in a water bottle every day.</p> <p>As the weather improves, children will need a sun hat and if you wish sun cream (which they must be able to apply themselves).</p> <p>Other updates will be posted on Class Dojo.</p>
