#### Welcome

#### Literacy

**Year 2** have started a new topic about instructional writing. They have already been busy completing a cold write and learning the key features.

**Year Four** have completed their fantasy stories and completed the topic with a hot write. They are now starting a new topic about poetry based on the topic of Christmas.
