#### Year 3

##### English

Year 3 have been enjoying looking at the book 'Jemmy Button'. So far we haven't read any of the story but we have been looking at the pictures in the book and inferring what we think is happening. We have written diary entries as Jemmy and written persuasive letters to Jemmy's parents. The children have also written about the Battle of Bosworth in history and have written an advert for Henry VIII.

##### Maths

The children have been learning about place value of hundreds, tens and units. They have ordered and compared 3 digit numbers and they have now moved onto adding ones onto 3 digit numbers.

##### Science

In Science, Year 3 have started learning about rocks. So far they have identified and classified rocks into igneous, metamorphic and sedimentary. They have also looked at erosion.

#### Year 4

##### English

Year 4 have been very busy learning all about newspapers. They have been focusing on the different features you can find in a newspaper and how to use them in the best way. They have also been writing all about the Battle of Bosworth for their History topic. Here they wrote an emotive diary in the role of Henry VII or Richard III.

##### Maths

The children have been revising their knowledge on Place Value. They have been expanding their learning on partitioning, ordering and finding more or less than numbers.

##### Science

In Science, Year 4 have been investigating different habitats and the organisms found there. The children have just learnt all about organisms and what they need in order to survive.
