Dear Parents and Carers,

As we reach the end of the academic year, I would like to thank you for your continued support of our schools and the Trust. Your partnership makes a real difference to the experience of every child.

It has been a pleasure to visit all of our schools several times this year and to spend time with pupils. Highlights have included seeing children enjoying reading, taking part in trips, including to Warwick Castle, and performing at Voice in a Million. Moments like these reflect the enthusiasm, ambition and opportunities across our Trust.

We have also seen encouraging improvements in attendance this year. Overall attendance has increased compared with last year, and levels of persistent absence are reducing. This reflects the strong partnership between schools and families in helping children attend regularly and make the most of their learning. We know that good attendance has a significant impact on children's outcomes, so we ask all families to continue working closely with their school to support this.

Your feedback through our parent surveys has been invaluable in helping us improve provision, communication and systems. We are always keen to hear your views and, next year, we will establish a SEND parent forum to strengthen the way we listen to and work with families of children with additional needs.

We have also been reviewing and updating our systems so that they work well for families and provide a more consistent experience across our schools. Next year, families will see a greater Trust presence in our schools, as well as the introduction of our Diamond 20. This will set out a shared group of experiences, opportunities and expectations that we want every child to benefit from during their time in a Diamond Trust school.

Like all schools and trusts, we continue to operate within a challenging national context. Pressures around SEND provision, funding and recruitment remain significant, alongside wider changes across the education system. However, our priority remains clear: to use our resources carefully, support our schools well, and continue strengthening the opportunities and experiences available to every child.

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank our staff across the Trust. Their dedication, expertise and care make a significant difference to the lives of children every day.

As we look ahead, our focus remains firmly on working together as one Trust to ensure that every child is supported, challenged and inspired to achieve their best. For those children moving on to the next stage of their education outside the Trust, we wish you every success and thank you for being such an important part of our Trust community.

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Thank you once again for your continued support throughout the year. I hope you and your families have a restful and enjoyable summer break, and we look forward to welcoming children back to school on 3 September.
