<p>Your child will bring home up to 2 books a week.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• One will be their coloured reading book</li><li>• One will be a book they have chosen from the library to share with you at home.</li></ul> <p>Please ensure that your child has their reading pack with them every day. They can change their reading books when needed and library books will be changed on a Monday.</p> <p>Please take time to share your reading in their diary. We love to find out how they have got on. We ask children to read 5 times a week and do a book talk (discussion and questions about the book) every week too.</p>	<p>Your child will bring spellings home every Wednesday. Please practise these at home and return them to school on Monday. The spellings will be a mix of the phonics sounds or spelling patterns they have been learning at school and tricky words.</p>	<p>This year, we are using NumBots for maths homework.</p> <p>The children should complete 30 minutes of questions.</p> <p>NumBots is an online maths game that supports children with their understanding, recall and fluency in mental addition and subtraction</p> <p>Their login details can be found in their reading diaries.</p>	<p>PE will be every Friday.</p> <p>Please make sure your child has their PE kit and earrings are removed.</p> <p>PE kit is black or navy shorts or joggers, white t-shirt and trainers (different to their school shoes).</p> <p>Please make sure that they have PE kit suitable for outdoors and as the weather gets colder.</p>	<p>Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the changing weather. This includes a suitable waterproof coat.</p> <p>Please make sure that all items of clothing are named.</p> <p>All children should bring in a water bottle every day.</p> <p>Other updates will be posted on Class Dojo.</p>
