<p>Your child will bring home up to 3 books a week.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One will be their reading book • One will be a reading for pleasure book. This is one they have chosen to enjoy at home. • One will be a book they have chosen from the library to share with you at home. <p>They can change their reading books everyday if needed and books for pleasure will be changed on Friday. Year 1 (Coleman) will change their library books on a Wednesday. Year 1 (Rashford) and all of Year 2 will change their library books on a Thursday. Please take time to share your reading in their diary. We love to find out how they have got on. We expect you to read 5 times a week and do a book talk every week too.</p>	<p>Your child will bring spellings home every Wednesday. Please practise these at home and return them to school on Monday. The spellings will be a mix of the phonics sounds or spelling patterns they have been learning at school and tricky words.</p>	<p>This term we are moving back to using NumBots for their maths homework in Years 1 and 2. The children should complete approximately 30 minutes of questions. NumBots is an online maths game that supports children with their understanding, recall and fluency in mental addition and subtraction. Their login details can be found in their reading diaries.</p>	<p>PE will be every Friday. Please make sure your child has their PE kit and earrings are removed. PE kit is black or navy shorts or joggers, white t-shirt and trainers. Please make sure that they have PE kit suitable for outdoors as the weather gets warmer.</p>	<p>Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the changing weather. This includes a suitable waterproof coat (lightweight for the summer).</p> <p>Please make sure that all items of clothing are named.</p> <p>All children should bring in a water bottle every day.</p> <p>As the weather improves, children will need a sun hat and if you wish sun cream (which they must be able to apply themselves).</p> <p>Other updates will be posted on Class Dojo.</p>
